



Some fun facts from 1982 – The Commodore 64 became the first popular home use computer; Epcot opened in Florida; Pat Sajak started as *The Wheel of Fortune* Host; *E.T.: The Extra-Terrestrial* and *Fast Times at Ridgemont High* were the movies to watch; a Sony Walkman was \$129; *Dallas*, *Magnum P.I.* and *The Dukes of Hazard* were the most watched TV shows; *I love Rock 'n Roll* by Joan Jett and the Blackhearts was the top song; *The Color Purple*, *North and South*, and *2010: Odyssey Two* led the most popular books; *Cats* opened on Broadway; the San Francisco 49ers were the Superbowl XVI Champions; the Penn State Nittany Lions won their first NCAA Football Championship under coach Joe Paterno; and Diana, Princess of Wales, was the most famous person in the world.

Locally, probably the most notable event in 1982 - the first Gala Auction to benefit the Franklin Unit of the American Cancer Society - was held on May 21st, ending at 1am and attended by over 400 people at the downtown Eagles Club. This auction topped the \$7,000 mark, far exceeding the \$1,800 raised the year before in a door-to-door solicitation. It was spearheaded by an organizing committee, with members Charles Strausbaugh (Chairman), Ellen Ternes, Jeff Rhodes, Dave Logan and Lloyd Hamberger, and a steering committee comprised of community leaders Joe Ausherman, Marion Grove, Zane Miller, and Undine Warner. Additionally, the countless number of volunteers stepped up and two auctioneers, Bob Benchoff and Jerry Scruggs, donated their time and dressed up for the occasion in top hats and white tuxes and got the highest bids for the 200 items, all sold on the live auction. Some of the donated items included a lamb, four singing telegrams, lunch with Representative Bud Shuster, a classical piano concert, a bus trip to Niagara Falls, an hour as a co-disc jockey on WAYZ, a Smith Corona manual typewriter, a cap worn by comedienne Carol Burnett in her washerwoman skit, *To Kill a Mockingbird* script autographed by movie icon Gregory Peck, and a June Lockhart autographed apron like the one worn by her on the television show *Lassie*.

Here we are 40 years later, holding a Gala Auction with over 150 dedicated volunteers and five auctioneers to raise money for local cancer organizations – over \$2.5 million since 1981. To say we are grateful would be an understatement. We couldn't do this without the Community, Commitment, and Compassion shown by our generous community each and every year. The area industries, businesses, professional, and individuals have been extremely supportive, and we are very appreciative.

A few of us are 'retiring' from the committee after this year – Mike Beck (32 years), Carole Carbaugh (25 years), Terry and Paula Eigenbrode (16 years), Dawn Keller (20 years), Bonnie Rhodes (33 years), Jeff Rhodes (40 years), Kay Singer (17 years), and myself (24 years). We are "family" and I feel very fortunate to have worked with them and those who "retired" in years past, to keep bringing our organizing ideas to reality. I thank each committee member for committing 100% of their efforts to make sure the auction lives up to its reputation as THE local fundraiser to attend each spring.

We hope you enjoy this year's Gala Auction and thank you again for your generous support.

Terms of Sale

1. All items will be sold to the highest bidder. All sales are final.
2. All payments must be made in full the night of the auction. **Bidders must be at least 18 years of age.** Positive ID is required.
3. Payment must be made with cash, credit card or check, made payable to the **Waynesboro Area Gala Cancer Auction or WAGCA.**
4. No bidder or recipient of an auction item shall return the item to the merchant/donor for refund or exchange unless specifically stated on the item.
5. All certificates must be redeemed by date specified or no later than March 31, 2023. It is strongly urged that bidders purchasing gift certificates make sure to arrange for dates as soon as possible to avoid scheduling problems.

Silent Auction Bidding Rules

1. All items on the silent auction tables have numbered bid cards attached or affixed nearby. Persons desiring to bid do so by writing their bid number and bid amount on the topmost blank line on the bid card. All bids must be written in ink.
2. **EACH ITEM WILL HAVE A MINIMUM STARTING BID AND MINIMUM INCREMENT DESIGNATED ON THE BID CARD.** Each increase in bid must equal or exceed the minimum increment figure stated on the card.
3. Silent auction items will be open for bid at Green Grove Gardens at 4 p.m. Your bid number will be good for both silent and oral auction items.
4. Because of limited space at the tables **CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 18 WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE SILENT AUCTION AREA** unless accompanied by an adult.
5. Silent auction tables will close to bidding at various times throughout the evening. Each closing time will be announced. The last correct bid highlighted by an auction official constitutes the winning bid.
6. Winning bidders will be announced after the closing of each table. Winning bidders should **REPORT IMMEDIATELY** to the appropriate table with **BIDDER NUMBER** to claim their items. **NO ITEM WILL BE GIVEN WITHOUT BIDDER NUMBER.** It is the bidder's responsibility to pick up items.
7. In the event of a dispute or an anticipated dispute, an auction official may remove the item from the silent table and move it to the podium for oral auction.
8. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY THE BID CARD BE REMOVED FROM THE SILENT TABLES. IF A BIDDING CARD IS REMOVED, THAT ITEM WILL BE WITHDRAWN FROM THE AUCTION.**
9. Auction officials reserve the right to move items between silent tables and oral auction.
10. Please give the clerks appropriate time to enter the bidding information into the computer before trying to check out after having a winning bid on the silent tables.






